In a previous semester we studied the palazzo as a building type and considered its relevance for a contemporary urban development. This semester we revisited it, but in this instance in the city that it originates from; notably Rome.

While a palazzo and palazzina are typologically similar as their name indicates, they differ in that the first is a large house, while the second is a multioccupancy building that is volumetrically similar to a palazzo.

Students began by investigating the definition of this building type and the

Students began by investigating the definition of this building type and the manner in which it can support a well-defined urban arrangements. This required the study of precedents and existing models. From the lessons learnt from this study they then developed an urban plan or strategy that tested how palazzine could be added to the 6 sites and neighbourhood chosen for projects.

The positioning and space between buildings was carefully developed by

The positioning and space between buildings was carefully developed by testing a range of options. The character and quality of the public realm and shared amenity was also considered, as well as the impact any project had on its wider context and on its more immediate neighbours. Finally, the design of a single building and the internal organisation of apartments was explored, and how it could be repeated or adjusted in different settings.

The projects contained in this catalogue explore a building type that is rather prevalent in Rome and consider the necessary steps needed to make a contemporary version while maintaining a relationship to its common character.
