




Over the course of the academic year 2021-22, the studio worked on public building programmes. In the Autumn semester 2021 we focused on *Shul* – the Yiddish word for synagogue derived from the German for school, *Schule* – as a building type. The building is intended to serve the needs of the Liberal Jewish Community as a home for collective use, a place for ritual practice and religious study. Students were invited to propose projects for one of several sites in Zurich.


At the beginning of the semester, a survey of exemplary buildings was undertaken. These are now catalogued here as an exploration of the synagogue as a building type.

A study trip to Zurich was undertaken at the beginning of the semester to visit the proposed project sites and develop an understanding of the needs of the Liberal Jewish Community the project is intended to serve. A number of lectures and presentations were organized during the semester to support and inform students following the course. Particular emphasis was placed on the study of the atmosphere of each of the buildings in terms of its contribution to the architectural ambitions of the project. This required the building of large, accurate models, as well threedimensional drawings.

Synagogue interior, Chodorow, Ukraine, 1642-1941


