We believe that cities should find opportunities to densify within their existing boundaries before considering expanding into their surroundings. In the context of the European city, we believe suitable building types and a degree of density appropriate to the place in question should be encouraged.



Our work considered the legacy of the city's long history and drew upon its rich architectural culture to transform the chosen sites, which lie at opposite ends of the city centre.

Both the sites we selected are currently being considered by the municipality as potential areas for development in the near future, as they are surplus to current needs.



Like many other cities, Milan suffers from a lack of decent housing, so that the key workers who ensure it functions must travel long distances to find affordable places to live.



Plan of the area under investigation




































































































































































